NIAC's membership year starts **February 1st**.

The annual fee within Ontario is \$60 (includes access to shared, printed materials and NIAC meetings).

For members outside Ontario the annual fee is \$40, which covers promotion via the NIAC website.

If you send your membership payment (new or renewal) postmarked by February 1st 2010, you may enjoy last year's pricing of \$50 for ON and \$30 for other Provinces.

New members may join at any time during the NIAC year but your fee will not be pro-rated and the \$60 for Ontario and \$40 for other Provinces applies.

Please note: NSF cheques will be subject to an additional \$25 administrative charge (in addition to membership fees).

Following receipt of your membership form and dues, you will receive a welcome letter. This letter will give you the information you need to receive all the benefits of membership:
